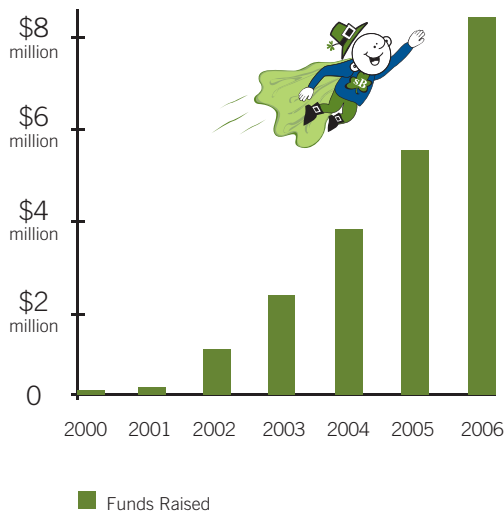

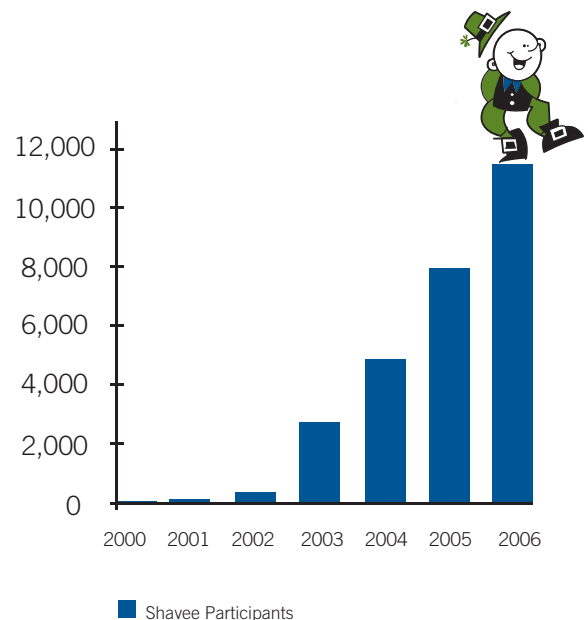
St. Baldrick's donation history



- People love going bald! They find it liberating and are proud to show solidarity with kids going through chemotherapy.
- Often two or three generations of a family will be shorn at the same time!
- St. Albert the Great Parochial School in Louisville, KY, holds the current record for the biggest school event. In 2006, 184 shavees raised \$55,741 for the cause.
- In 2006, the 10,000th registered male shavee was a firefighter from Geneva, IL, and over 960 female shavees signed up to be shorn at various venues throughout the world.
